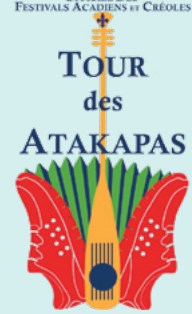


In lieu of paper tickets we will be using cashless wristbands at all beverage locations. Visit our JD Bank RFID Wristband locations to get your wristband.
